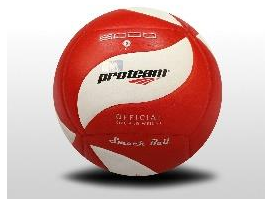
The KCS annual Christmas program promises to be a wonderful celebration of the TRUE meaning of Christmas and you are invited!
